

Nuclear Cardiac Stress Test Instructions

- 1. Your test will take approximately **3-4 hours at the N. Davis Highway office.** You will be given a radioactive tracer (*IT IS NOT CONTRAST DYE*) which allows for imaging of the blood flow through your heart before & after the stressing portion. The stressing procedure consists of walking on a treadmill OR a chemical stressing agent for those who are unable to walk on the treadmill. **Due to the radioactivity in your system, you should keep a distance from pregnant women & small children for 24 hours after the test.** Should you have any questions or need to reschedule please call us at (850) 696-4200.
- 2. Eating/Drinking: Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight, except plain water.
- 3. **Caffeine**: Please do not eat or drink anything with **caffeine (or decaffeinated)** for **24 hours** before your test.
- 4. **Nicotine/Tobacco:** Please do not use any products containing nicotine or tobacco the morning of test.
- 5. What to wear: Please wear loose, comfortable pants or shorts (no dresses/skirts) and a metal free short sleeve top (button down shirt if possible). Please bring a sweater or light jacket. Please wear athletic type closed toe shoes.
- Medications: Nitroglycerin Do not take on the day of the exam but do bring it with you.
 Diabetic medications & Bronchial inhalers: Please bring them with you should you need them.

DO NOT take any of the following medications 24 hours prior to the test but BRING THEM WITH YOU (should you need to take them after the stressing portion).
